POSITION SUMMARY

This Position will support the Southern California Conference in fulfilling its vision of Embracing Community in Christ and its mission to exalt Christ by serving its diverse communities through networked and creatively engaged churches and schools. Embody the organization's values of integrity with transparency, engagement, stewardship, unity in diversity, and relationships and team.

Provide cleaning for the church facilities to ensure that the facilities are clean and ready for use prior to the next service or function. The church janitor needs to be a member of the Seventh-day Adventist Church and attend the Seventh Day Adventist Church on a regular basis

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- 1. Regular attendance.
- 2. Vacuums carpeted areas and chairs.
- 3. Cleans and polishes wood furniture.
- 4. Sweeps, scrubs, waxes, and polishes floors, restrooms and kitchen.
- 5. Clean and sanitize all restrooms, restocking as necessary.
- 6. Empties waste baskets and transports trash to disposal area.
- 7. Maintains equipment and supplies.
- 8. Is responsible for setting up/taking down equipment and opening/closing doors for church functions and makes sure that lights are turned on/off.
- 9. Cleans all drinking fountains.
- 10. Replenished paper supplies in dispensers.
- 11. Dust surfaces throughout the facility (including artificial plants).
- 12. Maintain a clean environment for the outside of the church. Checking outside sidewalks and entry areas and picking up any trash found there. Keep walkways, breezeways, and entrances swept or blown as necessary.
- 13. Reporting when supplies are needed and reporting any items needing maintenance or repair to the maintenance dept.
- 14. Perform other related duties as assigned by supervisor.

- 15. Comply with policies and procedures of Southern California Conference, including but not limited to those in the employee handbook, and the North American Division Working Policy.
- 16. Perform other duties as assigned.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job, the individual must:

- Possess a high school diploma or hold a general education degree (GED) certificate.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS
